



- Services include: **medical, behavioral, dental, and other healthcare services.**
- Located in public schools in **underserved rural and urban** areas of New York with
- For many students this is their **only access to primary care.**

Demographic Tidbits

Insurance Status

33% of SBHC patients are uninsured or of unknown insurance status while 36% are covered by Medicaid

Race

34% of students identified as unknown, 21% as white, 19% as black, and 19% as other

Age

The largest demographic of SBHC users were **14-18 at 47%**, While **5-10 comprised 26%**

More than half (56%) of students who used SBHCs identified as Hispanic





47% of students age 11-20 were screened for **depression**
